

Installing Monitoring Tool, Remote Setup Tool, and/or Admin Client on Other Machines

Note: For machines that can not be installed via the Remote Setup Tool (Windows XP Home, Windows 98, ME, and Vista) you need to use this option to install the monitoring agent manually.

On the machine that you wish to install the software:

- 1) Navigate through your network to the machine you have set up as your BeAware server
- 2) You should see a folder “BCSNetSetup”
- 3) In this folder you should see BCS Client Setup.exe. Click on this file to start the installation. Click the Next Button and follow the prompts.
- 4) During the install you will be taken to a screen that will allow you to install the following components. Uncheck the boxes for the items you do not wish to install:
 - a. BCS Client and Monitoring Application – Installs the BeAware monitoring agent on the current machine. **Note:** This will require an Agent / Seat license to be available. If you do not wish to monitor the activities on this machine, DO NOT select this option.
 - b. Remote Setup Tool – Allows anyone with access to this machine to configure and/or install machines to be monitored. **Note:** It is NOT recommended to install this on and machine that is currently being monitored!
 - c. BeAware Admin Console – Installs the Admin console so that you can view the recorded data that has been uploaded. **Note:** You must have an Admin license available to log in.
- 5) Once you have selected the option(s) you wish to install, continue clicking the Next button to complete the install.

If you installed the Monitoring client, you will need to reboot after install to ensure that your data is recorded properly.
